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before there could be a revolution there was a rebellion before patriots there were insurgents challenging and displacing decades of received wisdom t h breen s strikingly original book explains how ordinary americans most of them members of farm families living in small communities were drawn into a successful insurgency against imperial authority this is the compelling story of our national political origins that most americans do not know it is a story of rumor charity vengeance and restraint american insurgents american patriots reminds us that revolutions are violent events they provoke passion and rage a willingness to use violence to achieve political ends a deep sense of betrayal and a strong religious conviction that god expects an oppressed people to defend their rights the american revolution was no exception a few celebrated figures in the continental congress do not make for a revolution it requires tens of thousands of ordinary men and women willing to sacrifice kill and be killed breen not only gives the history of these ordinary americans but drawing upon a wealth of rarely seen documents restores their primacy to american independence mobilizing two years before the declaration of independence american insurgents in all thirteen colonies concluded that resistance to british oppression required organized violence against the state they channeled popular rage through elected committees of safety and observation which before 1776 were the heart of american resistance american insurgents american patriots is the stunning account of their insurgency without which there would have been no independent republic as we know it

in 1996 congress commissioned the national park service to compile a list of sites and landmarks connected with the american revolution that it deemed vital to preserve for future generations some of these sites are well known bunker hill valley forge fort ticonderoga and in no danger of being lost others less so blackstock s plantation in south carolina or bryan s station in kentucky and more vulnerable but all are central to the story of our nation s fight for independence from battlefields to encampments meeting houses to museums these places offer us a chance to rediscover the remarkable men and women who founded this nation and to recognize the relevance of not just what they did but where they did it the american revolution a historical guidebook takes readers to nearly 150 of these sites providing an overview of the revolution through an exploration of the places where american independence was articulated fought for and eventually secured beginning with the boston common first

occupied by british troops in 1768 and closing with fraunces tavern in new york where george washington bid farewell to his officers on december 4 1783 kennedy takes readers on a tour of the most significant places of revolutionary history accompanied by illuminating excerpts and essays from some of the foremost scholars in the field including david mccullough barbara tuchman david hackett fischer eric foner and john ferling the entries move in a roughly chronological order from the pre revolutionary years up through 1787 taken together the combination of site essay and excerpt provides rich context and overview giving a sense of the major figures and events as well as the course of the revolution and cover topics ranging from the boston tea party to the frontier wars the guide is encyclopedic in scope and covers a wide geographical sweep accompanied by historical maps as well as a number of illuminating primary documents including the declaration of independence and letters from john adams and george washington it offers a comprehensive picture of how the revolutionary war unfolded on american soil and also points readers to the best writing on the subject in the last fifty years the american revolution a historical guidebook is an essential companion for anyone interested in the story and history of our nation s founding

this concise accessible text provides students with a history of american constitutional development in the context of political economic and social change constitutional historian michael benedict stresses the role that the american people have played over time in defining the powers of government and the rights of individuals and minorities he covers important trends and events in u s constitutional history encompassing key supreme court and lower court cases the volume begins by discussing the english and colonial origins of american constitutionalism following an analysis of the american revolution s meaning to constitutional history the text traces the constitution s evolution from the early republic to the present day this third edition is updated to include the election of 2000 the tea party and the rise of popular constitutionalism and the rise of judicial supremacy as seen in cases such as citizens united the affordable care act and gay marriage

born of clashing visions of empire in england and the colonies the american revolution saw men and women grappling with power and its absence in dynamic ways on both sides of the revolutionary divide americans viewed themselves as an imperial people this perspective conditioned how they understood the exercise of power how they believed governments had to function and how they situated themselves in a world dominated by other imperial players eighteenth century americans experienced what can be called an imperial revolutionary moment over the course of the eighteenth century the colonies were integrated into a broader atlantic world a process that forced common men and women to reexamine the meanings and influences of empire in their own lives the tensions inherent in this process led to revolution after the revolution the idea of empire provided order albeit at a cost to many during a chaotic period viewing the early republic from an imperial revolutionary perspective the essays in this collection consider subjects as far ranging as merchants winemaking slavery sex and chronology to nostalgia fort construction and urban unrest they move from the very center of the empire in london to the far western frontier near st louis offering a new way to consider america s most formative period

elizabeth and henry drinker of philadelphia were no friends of the american revolution yet neither were they its enemies the drinkers were a merchant family who being quakers and pacifists shunned commitments to both the revolutionaries and the british they strove to endure the war uninvolved and unscathed they failed in 1777 the war came to philadelphia when the city was taken and occupied by the british army aaron sullivan explores the british occupation of philadelphia chronicling the experiences of a group of people who were pursued pressured and at times persecuted not because they chose the wrong side of the revolution but because they tried not to choose a side at all for these people the war was neither a glorious cause to be won nor an unnatural rebellion to be suppressed but a dangerous and costly calamity to be navigated with care both the patriots and the british referred to this group as the disaffected perceiving correctly that their defining feature was less loyalty to than a lack of support for either side in the dispute and denounced them as opportunistic apathetic or even treasonous sullivan shows how revolutionary authorities embraced desperate measures in their quest to secure their own legitimacy suppressing speech

controlling commerce and mandating military service in 1778 without the patriots firing a shot the king's army abandoned philadelphia and the perceived threat from neutrals began to decline as did the coercive and intolerant practices of the revolutionary regime by highlighting the perspectives of those wearied by and withdrawn from the conflict the disaffected reveals the consequences of a revolutionary ideology that assumed the nation's people to be a united and homogenous front

traces the political disputes that surrounded america's 1776 declaration of independence offering insight into the views of parliament sympathizers and colonists who stayed loyal to britain by the best selling author of the ascent of george washington 50 000 first printing

well documented entertaining this excellent popular history should attract a wide audience with its fresh perspective publishers weekly drawing on hundreds of specialist sources contemporary and archival patriot battles is the comprehensive one volume study of the military aspects of the war of independence the first part of the book offers a richly detailed examination of the nuts and bolts of eighteenth century combat for example who fought and what motivated them whether patriot or redcoat hessian or frenchman how were they enlisted and trained how were they clothed and fed what weapons did they use and how effective were they when soldiers became casualties or fell ill how did medical services deal with them what roles did loyalists women blacks and indians play the second part of the book gives a closer look at the war's greatest battles with maps provided for each which men were involved and how many what was the state of their morale and equipment what parts did terrain and weather play what were the qualities of the respective commanders and what tactics did they employ how many casualties were inflicted and no less important how did the soldiers fight throughout many cherished myths are challenged reputations are reassessed and long held assumptions are tested for all readers patriot battles is one of the most satisfying and illuminating works to be added to the literature on the war of independence in many years an interesting and easily digestible study appealing to both military history buffs and general readers booklist an iconoclastic provocative study of the revolutionary war that invalidates a few chestnuts kirkus reviews

in 1810 the atlantic world was embroiled in revolution piracy proxy wars and clandestine operations napoleon had invaded spain the louisiana territory was in crisis and americans were preparing to declare war against the british beset at home the spanish struggled to maintain their colonial empire while u s officials and agents plotted their departure from texas and florida an outcome forestalled until general andrew jackson's 1815 victory at new orleans and the british change in position regarding spain's possessions after napoleon's final defeat in europe americans may have professed neutrality in mexico's sanguinary civil war but their actions proved otherwise this first book linking america with the mexican struggle for independence examines guerrilla warfare and royalist reaction in mexico the common cause between mexican and american patriots in ousting the spanish the secret efforts by americans to convey insurgents and arms into their revolution and the effect of the war and its aftermath on the destiny of a continent
